PRELIMINARIES

Dr. Marc Alexei Caesar Badajos, CPSU Vice President for Administration and Finance, presided over the meeting. He asked the body for additional matters to be included in the agenda. The meeting started with a prayer.

The Secretary mentioned that mostly of the members of the administrative council are present, hence quorum was declared by the Presiding Officer.

Some more comments were asked, since there was none, upon motion duly made by Dr. Deocares and was duly seconded by Dr. Alfaras agenda presented was adopted. **CARRIED**.

DISCUSSION PROPER

1. Administrative and Finance Update;

The report was presented by Dr. Badajos, the VPAF.

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- DBM granted 93 plantilla item for non-teaching personnel for the Main Campus.
- ➢ 37.312 million Bid projects
- > Approval of the Board of Regents of the CPSU LUDIP for 10 campuses
- Operationalization of the CPSU Campus Wifi. MIS office was able to issue 300 vouchers already to students.

Dr. Badajos mentioned that operations of the Peso Wifi inside the campus is not allowed for they were not able to ask permit or permission to operate. To show respect, they have to asked approval or inform the MIS about their operations.

- In terms of the budget utilization rate (GAA) we are already 50.54% which means CPSU was able to disburse already 50% of the budget as of June.
- $\succ~$ CPSU have obligated BUR of 74.51% which is around 521.7 million
- ➢ He also clarified about the budget of the university the lowers for almost 11 million. He mentioned that there is reduction in the Free Higher Education Subsidy or the Tuition and Miscellaneous of the students. He added that before, CPSU receives 279 million (2021 and 2022). However, in 2024, they were able to noticed that the enrollment in 2021 only reached up to 250 million. That it why is 2024, it was reduced by 30 million. He emphasized to stick on the absorptive capacity and actual enrollment because there will be difficulties in looking for fund to pay for the students who exceed the capacity of the University. He highlighted that it is the reason why CPSU has suffered from budget reduction
- He also mentioned that PS increased and there are personnels who were reclassified.
- He also added that there is also increased in the MOOE due to the inflation.
- In terms of income, there is a very low-income utilization particularly in Retained Income due to a combination of non-requests from end uses, long period (more than one year) of project implementation, sports activities falling within the last quarter of the year, and late award of some projects. He added that some of these are fiduciary fund and can't be utilized

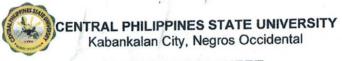
